## JUNIOR NETBALL PROGRAMME STARTING 11<sup>th</sup> May 2015

This is the new Netball NZ junior programme designed for new players. This is for those players in years 1-4 who haven't played before. As most year 3 and 4 players are still in the current future ferns teams these sessions will predominately be years 1 and 2. We really encourage you to get involved as the sessions are fun for the girls and boys. The session is based on a particular skill focus and then the players are able to try this in a game situation. Player numbers and court size is reduced. You can register as an individual or get a group of friends together.
